आरडीएसएस सिहत बिजली क्षेत्र की वितरण योजनाओं के कार्यान्वयन में वास्तविक समय पर अपडेट और अंतर्हष्टि प्रदान करने के लिए यह अभिनव मंच लॉन्च किया गया है, जिससे पारदर्शिता और दक्षता सक्षम हो सके। प्लेटफॉर्म (https://rdss.powermin.gov.in/) केंद्रीय विद्युत और नवीन एवं नवीकरणीय ऊर्जा मंत्री श्री आर.के. सिंह द्वारा राज्यों और राज्य बिजली उपयोगिताओं के साथ समीक्षा योजना और निगरानी (आरपीएम) बैठक में 10-11 अप्रैल, 2023 के दौरान नई दिल्ली में लॉन्च किया गया था।
